This is targeting on education (Civic Education and PETS --- Public Expenditure Tracking Systems), advocacy, lobbying and awareness creation to the community. The S2C is specifically taken in schools and colleges to raise awareness and consciousness of youths who will in-turn influence their communities.)</p> <p>c) Climate and Environmental Care-- it is a cross cutting program - integrated in all programs of the organization. (Under this program we do have the ICT Solar Kiosk- as a center for supporting Youth creativity)</p> <p>d) Sport for development Program (Various sports and arts performances- it is a cross cutting program)</p> <p>e) Right Based Services (more focus in assisting and empowering community for accessing service rights such as health and education)</p> <p>It is the focus of the organization to keep on implementing its Mission and objectives by making sure that youth/s and community at large are empowered, healthier and enjoys their lives.</p>
